



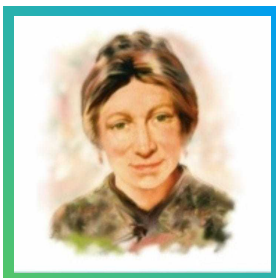
FCJ Summer Program in Myanmar: Ecological Awareness
