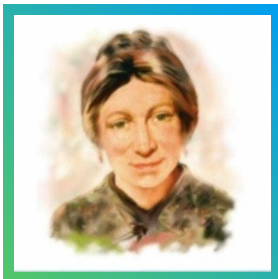

On 19 June 2019, some students of Campion Institute Pastoral Care (CIPCA) with Sr Narni, fcJ organized the *Youth Inter Faith Gathering for Peace* at [Campion Institute](#), Yangon.
